# NATIONAL AFFAIRS

## **UN Security Council issues**

- India and Ireland held the bilateral consultations on **UN Security Council issues.**
- During the bilateral consultations, both the countries congratulated each other for their election to United **Nation Security Council.**

#### Mahanadi-Godavari Link

- The task force on Interlinking of Rivers has approved the Mahanadi-Godavari Link.
- The linking project was approved by ensuring the utilisation of allocated Godavari waters by the states of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> edition of the Khelo India Winter Games

- The second edition of the Khelo India Winter Games began at Gulmarg in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.
- The Minister of State for Youth Affairs & Sports, Kiren Rijiju, reached Srinagar to attend the event.

### E-Daakhil portal

- The Ministry of consumer affairs had decided to integrate the Common Service Centres with the **EDaakhil portal** to facilitate the consumers for **e-filing**.
- It empowers the consumer and their advocates to file consumer complaints online.

### 16th FICCI Higher Education Summit

- The Union education minister, addressed the 16<sup>th</sup> FICCI **Higher Education Summit.**
- The policy allows the **students to be more creative in** their respective fields since it focuses on entrepreneurship, innovation and skill development.

#### **BRICS Financial Cooperation**

- India hosted the meeting of **BRICS finance and central** bank deputies. It was the first meeting on the BRICS Financial Cooperation under India Chairship in 2021.
- It was co-chaired by Economic Affairs Secretary Tarun Bajaj and RBI Deputy Governor Michael Patra.

#### **Financial Action Task Force**

- The Global anti-terrorism watchdog Financial Action Task Force decided to maintain Pakistan into Grey List till June 2021.
- This decision by the FATF was taken in the light of country's failure to fully comply with the 27-point action plan of to combat the terrorism.
