NATIONAL AFFAIRS

National Toy Fair

- The first-ever National Toy Fair will be starting from the February 27th, 2021. The toy fair is being organised by the Ministry of Textiles.
- During the event, the Centre for Creative Learning, which is based in IIT Gandhinagar, will showcase its 75 toy creations in the fair.

Corps Commander Level Meeting

- The 10th round of Corps Commander Level Meeting between India and China was held on the Chinese side of the Line of Actual Control in Moldo.
- Both the sides appraised the smooth completion of disengagement of troops at the Pangong Lake area.

STATE AFFAIRS

Co-ownership rights to Women

- The **Uttarakhand** government has issued an **ordinance** providing the co-ownership rights to women in the ancestral property of their husband.
- It was put forward in the backdrop of large-scale migration of men from hill areas of the state to look for livelihood.

Hoshangabad city renamed as Narmadapuram

- The CM of Madhya Pradesh, Shivraj Chouhan, has announced to rename the **Hoshangabad** city of MP as Narmadapuram.
- Hoshangabad city was named after an attacker Hoshang Shah who was the first ruler of Malwa.

Paperless budget

- Uttar Pradesh has become the first Indian State that has tabled the paperless budget. The State finance minister, Suresh Khanna presented State Budget.
- The document was also made available on the App named as "Uttar Pradesh Sarkar Ka Budget".

- Saudi Arabia has opened up the armed forces for Women.

State Bank of Sikkim

- The Reserve Bank of India has brought the State Bank of Sikkim under its regulation. It is a state-owned banking institution.
- It was established in the year 1968. Until February 21, 2021, it was not regulated by Reserve Bank of India unlike other banks.

Kala Namak rice

- Uttar Pradesh is all set to export Kala Namak rice to **Singapore**. This rice is also called as **Buddha Rice**. It is one of the finest varieties of aromatic rice that are grown in India.
- The rice was offered to the Buddhist monks so as to promote the rice in **Buddhist countries**.

- The **Zoological Survey of India** has prepared a **report** on mass migration of the blue earthworms in the state of Meghalaya.
