NATIONAL AFFAIRS

Maritime India Summit

- 'Maritime India Summit 2021' is being organised by the Ministry of Ports.
- India will invest **USD 82 billion** in port projects by 2035 (under Sagarmala Programme), raise the share of clean renewable energy sources in the maritime sector.

Merchant Digitization Summit

- The Government of India, Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry, and UNbased Better than Cash Alliance hosted Merchant Digitization Summit 2021: Towards Atma Nirbhar Bharat.
- It focused on **Empowering women merchants** who play critical roles in their communities is one of the priorities to help achieve the mission of **Digital India**.

Exercise Desert Flag-VI

- **Indian Air Force**, for the first time participating in the Exercise Desert Flag-VI, hosted by the United Arab **Emirates Air Force.**
- Ex Desert Flag is an annual multinational large force employment warfare exercise.

"Swachhta Saarthi Fellowship"

- The Office of the Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India under its "Waste to Wealth" Mission launched the "Swachhta Saarthi Fellowship".
- It's objective is to recognize students, community workers and municipal workers who are engaged in the enormous challenge of waste management, scientifically and sustainably.

Marine Spatial Planning

- India & Norway agreed to collaborate in the area of Marine Spatial Planning in the Oceanic space for the next 5 years.
- Lakshadweep & Puducherry have been identified as Pilot sites for the Project.

Purple Revolution

- Farmers of Jammu had their incomes quadrupled after shifting from maize to lavender cultivation which is being called **purple revolution**.
- It was possible due to initiatives taken under **Aroma** Mission. Under purple revolution, farmers were given free lavender saplings.

Engineering Research & Development Policy

- Karnataka launched the country's first Engineering Research & Development Policy.
- The policy identified five key focus sectors such as aerospace and defence; auto, auto components and EV; biotechnology, pharma and medical devices; semiconductors, telecom, and software products.

'Liink', Blockchain-based network

- State Bank of India joined 'Liink', Blockchain-based data network of JPMorgan chase. The partnership will help SBI to reduce transaction costs, speed up Consumer transactions.
- SBI became the 1st bank in India to go live on the blockchain-based payment network.

NSE India signed a MoU with SIDBI

National Stock Exchange signed a MoU with the Small Industries Development Bank of India for the cooperation in the various Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises initiatives of NSE and SIDBI and to explore the feasibility of debt Capital Platform for the MSMEs.

ENVIRONMENT & GEOGRAPHY

Nationally Determined Contributions Synthesis Report

The UNFCCC, in its Nationally Determined Contributions Synthesis Report, has called for more ambitious climate action plans by the countries in order to achieve the Paris Agreement target of containing global temperature rise to 2°C (ideally 1.5°C) by the end of the century.

Black-Browed Babbler

- Black-Browed Babbler (Malacocincla perspicillata) was rediscovered in **Indonesia**. This bird is often called 'the biggest enigma in Indonesian ornithology'.
- It has a strong bill, chocolate colouring and distinctive black eye-stripe, its iris is of striking maroon colour.

• United Nations World Wildlife Day is annually observed across the globe on 3rd March to celebrate the wild fauna and flora across, with theme "Forests and Livelihoods: Sustaining People and Planet".
