#### INTERNATIONAL

### 1) Inmarsat-6 F1

Japan has launched Inmarsat-6 F1, a communication satellite, through a Mitsubishi Heavy Industries (MHI) H-IIA204 rocket from Japan's Tanegashima Space Center that will enter geostationary orbit, about 22,240 miles (35,790 kilometres) above the earth. It is the world's largest and most sophisticated commercial communications satellite ever launched.

## 2) NASA's Psyche mission

NASA's Psyche mission is going to be launched in August 2022. It will be the first launch to explore a giant metal asteroid known as Psyche in the main asteroid belt. The asteroid Psyche is in between Mars & Jupiter and is orbiting the Sun.

### 3) Centre for Economics and Business Research

The Centre for Economics and Business Research from the United Kingdom has predicted that the Indian economy will become the world's third-largest by the year 2031. In the year 2022, India is set to regain its sixth position in World Economic League Table (WELT) from France, as per CEBR.

## 1) BrahMos Aerospace cruise missile manufacturing unit

Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has laid the foundation stone of the BrahMos Aerospace cruise missile manufacturing unit in Lucknow. He also laid the foundation of DRDO Defence Technology and Test Centre in Lucknow. BrahMos missile derives its name from the Brahmaputra river of India and the Moskva river of Russia.

### 2) India cleared two more covid vaccines

India cleared two more covid vaccines and one pill. The two vaccines, Corbevax and Covovax, were approved by drug regulator Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation. Anti-viral drug Molnupiravir was also approved. It can be used only in an emergency situation.
