### 1) Reserve Bank of India

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) took a significant step on Friday by announcing an increase in the UPI payment limits from Rs 1 lakh to Rs 5 lakh.

## 2) Rs 2,500 crore for the Interest Equalisation Scheme

- The scheme is extended until June 30, 2024, aiming to support exporters from specific sectors and all MSME manufacturer exporters.
