## IMPORTANT DAYS

### 1) Ambedkar Jayanti

- Ambedkar Jayanti is celebrated on 14 April to commemorate the birth anniversary of Babasaheb Dr Bhim Rao Ambedkar.
- In 2022, the nation is celebrating 131st birth anniversary of Ambedkar.
- Dr Ambedkar is known as the Father (chief architect) of the Indian Constitution.
- He has been bestowed with the country's highest civilian honour, Bharat Ratna in 1990 posthumously.

### 2) World Chagas Disease Day

- World Chagas Disease Day is observed on 14th April.
- The day's objective is to raise public awareness and visibility among people about Chagas Disease (also called American trypanosomiasis or silent or silenced disease).
- Theme of 2022: "finding and reporting every case to defeat chagas disease."
