- A Gangetic Dolphin was beaten to death in Pratapgarh, Uttar Pradesh. Killing the Gangetic River Dolphin is a punishable offence under the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972.
- The Ganges river dolphin can only live in freshwater and is **essentially blind**.

Beema Bamboo Crash Barrier

- Experts from the Visvesvaraya National Institute of Technology, Nagpur, are working on the design of crash barriers made of beema bamboo and coir.
- These are being developed as a low-cost alternative to steel barriers to reduce accident deaths on highways.
