INTERNATIONAL

1) 1st ever Global strategy to defeat "Meningitis"

The World Health Organization along with its partners have launched the 1st ever Global strategy to defeat "Meningitis". The strategy "Global Roadmap to Defeat Meningitis by 2030" was launched by WHO Director-General, Dr Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus. Meningitis is an inflammatory disease that affects the membranes that surrounds the Brain & Spinal cord.

2) 'Renewable Energy Country Attractiveness Index 2021'

India has retained its 3rd rank in the 58th edition of Ernst & Young Global Limited's 'Renewable Energy Country Attractiveness Index 2021'. RECAI is a biannual report being released since 2003.

NATIONAL

1) "Ex Yudh Abhyas 2021"

The 17th edition of the Joint Military Training Exercise "Ex Yudh Abhyas 2021" between the Indian Army and the United States Army, is scheduled to take place in October 2021 at Joint Base Elmendorf Richardson, Alaska in USA. The Indian contingent will comprise of 350 personnel of an Infantry Battalion Group.
