#### **NATIONAL**

### 1) Central Administrative Tribunal

- CAT is focusing on fast disposal of cases of most vulnerable section of applicants like the senior citizens / pensioners.
- CAT had been established (1985) under Article 323 -A for adjudication of disputes and complaints with respect to recruitment and conditions of service of persons appointed to public services and posts.
- Members of the defence forces, officers and servants of Supreme Court and the secretarial staff of the Parliament are not covered by it.

## 2) Green Hydrogen

- Oil India Limited (OIL) has commissioned India's first 99.999% pure green hydrogen plant in Jorhat, Assam.
- It produced by splitting water into hydrogen and oxygen using renewable energy such as wind or solar power that does not entail greenhouse gas emissions.

# 3) Indian Naval Ship Vagsheer

- Indian Naval Ship Vagsheer, the sixth and last submarine of Project 75, has been launched. It is constructed by Mazagon Dock Ltd
- Vagsheer is a diesel attack submarine, designed to perform sea denial as well as access denial warfare.
- It is also capable of performing anti-surface warfare, anti-submarine warfare, intelligence gathering, mine laying and area surveillance related operations.

# 4) National Conference on Agriculture

- Recently, Narendra Singh Tomar, Union Agriculture Minister, launched the National Conference on Agriculture for the Kharif Campaign 2022-23 at the NASC Complex in New Delhi.
- The minister said that the centre and states will collaborate to secure the availability of herbicides and seeds, lowering farmers' input prices.
