INTERNATIONAL

1) Global Climate risk index 2021

The international environmental think tank 'Germanwatch' released the Global Climate risk index 2021. This is the 16th Edition of the Index. It is published annually. India has improved its rankings from last year. It is ranked 7th in the 2021 Index as compared to 5th in 2020 Index.

NATIONAL

1) PM Gati Shakti Scheme

The government of India has launched the ambitious Gati Shakti scheme or National Master Plan for multi-modal connectivity plan, with the aim of coordinated planning and execution of infrastructure projects to bring down logistics costs. The Gati Shakti scheme will subsume the Rs 110 lakh crore National Infrastructure Pipeline that was launched in 2019.

2) 28th anniversary of the National Human Rights Commission

The 28th anniversary of the National Human Rights Commission was observed on 12th October 2021. NHRC is a watchdog of human rights in the country, i.e. the rights related to life, liberty, equality and dignity of the individual guaranteed by Indian Constitution or embodied in the international covenants and enforceable by courts in India.

3) India's 1st Atal Community Innovation Center

India's 1st Atal Community Innovation Center was inaugurated at Vivekananda Global University, Jaipur (VGU). It will be the first centre in the country to be set up by the Government of India, Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) and NITI Aayog.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY

1) Kotak Mahindra Bank launches Micro ATMs across India

Kotak Mahindra Bank Ltd has announced the launch of Micro ATMs across the country. Customers of all banks who possess a debit card can use a Kotak Micro ATM for key banking services such as cash withdrawals and checking account balances. A mini version of an ATM, micro ATMs are small handheld devices.

GEOGRAPHY AND ENVIRONMENT

1) Kunming Declaration

The Kunning Declaration was adopted by over 100 countries at the ongoing 15th Conference of the Parties to the United Nations Convention on Biological Diversity in china. The adoption of the declaration will create momentum for a new global biodiversity pact.

1) Ireland's Amy Hunter becomes youngest batter to hit ODI hundred

Ireland's Amy Hunter hit 121 not out on her 16th birthday against Zimbabwe, making her the youngest batter to score an ODI century in either men's or women's cricket. The Belfast batter – who was playing in only her fourth ODI – broke the record previously held by India's Mithali Raj.
