INTERNATIONAL

1) "Remittance Prices Worldwide Database"

According to the latest report by the World Bank titled 'World Bank's Remittance Prices Worldwide Database', India became the world's largest recipient of remittances by receiving USD 87 billion in 2021. The United States (US) was its biggest source, accounting for over 20% of these funds. India is followed by China, Mexico, the Philippines, and Egypt.

NATIONAL

1) Indian Navy Conducts Security Exercise 'Prasthan'

The Indian Navy conducted a security exercise, called "Prasthan", in the Offshore Development Area off the coast of Mumbai. It's objective is to ensure offshore security and integrate maritime stakeholders. The drill focused on contingencies such as terrorist intrusion, bomb explosion, major fire, oil spill, man overboard etc.

STATE NEWS

1) AIIB approves USD 150 Million loan for Chennai Metropolitan Area

The Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank has approved a USD 150 million loan to the Government of India. The loan amount will be used for the implementation of the Sustainable Urban Services Program (SUSP) for the Chennai Metropolitan Area.

BUSINESS AND ECONOMY

1) SIDBI and Google tied-up to Support MSMEs

Small Industries Development Bank of India has entered into a collaboration with Google India Pvt Ltd for piloting a social impact lending programme with financial assistance up to Rs 1 crore at subsidized interest rates. The collaboration brings a corpus of \$15 million (about Rs. 110 crores) to micro-enterprises as a crisis response.

AWARDS AND RECOGNITIONS

1) 12th Manipur State Award for Literature 2020

Beryl Thanga has received the 12th Manipur State Award for Literature 2020 for his book – Ei Amadi Adungeigi Ithat' (I and the then island). Manipur Governor La. Ganesan conferred the award on the 65-year-old writer for his novel published in 2015. The award carries a plaque, citation, Rs. 3 lakh (in cheque) and a shawl.

2) Indian Film Personality of the Year award

Hema Malini, and lyricist and former CBFC chief Prasoon Joshi will be facilitated with the Indian Film Personality of the Year award at the International Film Festival of India 2021. Their contributions to the field of Indian cinema spread over decades and their body of work has enthralled audiences across generations.
