1) Amazon Future Engineer

2) 38th PRAGATI meeting

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has chaired the 38th PRAGATI meeting to review multiple projects, grievances and programmes of central and state government. PRAGATI stands for Pro-Active Governance and Timely Implementation. PRAGATI is a unique integrating and interactive platform, aimed at addressing common man's grievances.

3) IIFL Wealth Hurun India Rich List
